

AVAILABLE:

To the Town of Searsport for Municipal Fire Protection

RATE:

The rate for existing hydrants as installed on the system at May 1, 2026,
shall have an annual charge of

\$283,452 Annually
\$ 70,863 Quarterly
\$ 23,621 Monthly

Rate for hydrants installed after May 1, 2026, shall be determined
in accordance with the Public Utilities Commission Rules and Regulations
Chapter 69.


The hydrant rental charge shall not be reduced, should a Town order
one or more hydrants discontinued.

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

Charges under these rates will be billed and payable monthly in
advance, at the option of the District. All bills shall be due and payable upon presentation.

Unpaid balances of accounts thirty (30) days or more past due will be charged interest
at the rate which is set annually by the Public Utilities Commission of the State of Maine.

PRIVATE FIRE PROTECTION

AVAILABLE:

To customers using the District's service for private fire protection the following rates apply to fire protection only and include no allowance of water for other than fire fighting purposes.

RATES:

Private fire service rates for automatic sprinklers, standpipes or hose connections to be used only for fire protection inside of buildings.

Annual service charge per inch of service pipe diameter.

\$ 315

Annual service charge for each private hydrant with service connection furnished, installed and maintained by user for private fire protection.

\$ 1,889

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

Charges under these rates shall be billed and payable monthly in advance, at the option of the District. All bills shall be due and payable upon presentation.

Unpaid balances of accounts thirty (30) days or more past due will be charged interest at the rate set annually by the Public Utilities Commission of the State of Maine.
